### General English Courses

- Group General English courses available to students from Elementary to Advanced levels. Beginners are to book the Beginner's Course.
- Communicative English courses are ideal for students wishing to practise their conversational skills without focusing on grammar.
- 10 students max per class, 12 max in high season.
- FREE book offered to students taking group General English 20 or 30 lessons per week for a minimum duration of 2 weeks.
- Minimum course duration 1 week (Monday to Friday).

### Business English Courses

- Group Business English courses available to Pre-Intermediate + students. Beginner & Elementary students are to book Private Lessons.
- 6 students max per class.
- FREE Business English book offered to students taking group BE20/30 lessons.

### Private/Semi-Private courses

- Private/Semi-Private courses may be held outside the school, for example at student's own accommodation in St. Paul's Bay /Bugibba /Qawra at no extra charge. Other areas €25 per week travel supplement.
- Lessons on a Saturday/Public Holiday may also be offered upon request at double the price.
- A Personal Needs Analysis is to be filled in by each student for teacher to prepare lessons accordingly.

### Teen Course Information

- Teen Tuition (TT):** 20 General English lessons per week.
- Teen Explorer (TE):** 20 sessions per week. Students in small groups are accompanied by a fully-qualified English teacher. Sessions are held outside the school, for example on a sandy beach and at the same time as Kids Club and Adult GE courses. This course is ideal when booking a Family language course.
- Teen Activity Package (TAP)** is an all inclusive package consisting of 20 General English lessons per week, host family accommodation in a twin room on FB basis with laundry service, leisure activities and return airport transfers.
- Teen Activity Residence (TAR)** is an all inclusive package consisting of 20 General English lessons per week, residential accommodation in twin/triple rooms on FB basis, leisure activities and return airport transfers.
- TAR available for groups minimum 10 students. Free sharing accommodation for 1 group leader with every 10 students. Residence is a 15 minute walk from the school.

### Family Language & Kids Course Information

- **Family Language/KC course dates:** 29 March – 23 April (Easter), 17 May – 4 June (Pentecost), 28 June – 3 September (summer), 11 October – 5 November (autumn).
- KC is conveniently held at the same time as the adult GE20 course.
- KC includes 30 minutes supervision during the morning break. Kids are to be accompanied by their parent/guardian immediately before the start and after the end of their lessons.

### General Information for all students

- GV offers courses at levels corresponding to the Common European Framework (CEF), which is a system of level indicators for language courses used throughout Europe. These levels are: A1 – Breakthrough (Elementary); A2 – Waystage (Pre-Intermediate); B1 – Threshold (Intermediate); B2 – Vantage (Upper Intermediate); C1 – Effective Operational Proficiency (Advanced).
- Courses held from Monday to Friday.
- Books are not provided for Kids, Teens, Private, Semi-Private, Exam or 1-week GE courses.
- Students who are given a FREE book are advised not to write on it unless they are satisfied with the level of their class. If a student changes class, books that have been damaged or written on cannot be exchanged.

### Holidays

### Reduction of Hours

- A minimum of *three* students required to offer regular *General English, Communicative English, Exam Courses, Teen Tuition, Teen Explorer and Kids Club* courses. If there are two or less students per class, 10 lessons will be reduced to 5; 20 to 15; 30 to 20; 40 to 30. There will be no change in fees.
- A minimum of *two* students required to offer regular *Business English*. If there is only one student per class, 10 lessons will be reduced to 5; 20 to 15; 30 to 20. There will be no change in fees.
- On weeks when there is one Public Holiday, the timetable for *General English, Teen Tuition, Teen Explorer, Kids Club and Exam* courses will be extended by 30 minutes per day. The *Intensive and Communicative English* session will be extended by an extra 15 minutes per day.
- On weeks when there are two Public Holidays, the timetable for *General English, Teen Tuition, Teen Explorer and Kids Club* courses will be extended by 1.5 hours per day. The *Intensive and Communicative English* session will be extended by an extra 30 minutes per day. There is no refund for lessons missed due to public holidays.
- *Business English, Super Intensive, Private and Semi-Private* lessons missed will be made up.

### Course Certificates

All students are given a certificate at the end of the course.

### Terms & Conditions 2010

#### English Only Policy

In order to provide students with a complete English immersion, GV Malta follows a strict English Only Policy, where students are encouraged to speak English only on campus.

#### Leisure Activities

We offer a variety of excursions and trips that one may choose from all year round. GV Malta reserves the right to make changes to the activities programme due to weather conditions, attraction closures or any other reasons beyond our control.

#### Placement Test

Upon booking and prior to arrival students are to answer a Placement Test to verify their English level.

This enables students not to miss the first lessons on the first day.

#### Orientation Day

On the first Monday of the course, new students are welcomed and placed in an appropriate class according to his/her level. If a student does not reach the required minimum level for a specific course, s/he may be asked to change to Private Lessons or another course available.

#### Airport Transfers

All flight details as requested in our Registration Form MUST reach us at least 4 days prior to arrival. In the event of delays or sudden flight changes students MUST inform the airport transfer company in sufficient time. No refund will be given in the event of subsequent missed transfers.

#### Unaccompanied Minors

Students travelling as unaccompanied minors require a GV representative to provide an additional service upon arrival and departure. The charge for this service is €20 each way. Please advise at the time of booking if the student is travelling as an unaccompanied minor.

#### Curfew Times for Teens

Ages 16 – 17: Sunday – Thursday 00:00, Friday – Saturday: 01:00

Under 16: Sunday – Thursday 22:00, Friday – Saturday: 23:00

Should students wish to stay out later, the school requires written authorisation from their parents/guardians along with contact details of the parent/guardian for verification.

#### Teen & Kids Lessons/Activities

Participation in lessons and prepaid activities is compulsory. Should teens/kids not wish to attend any lessons or activities, the school requires written authorisation from parents/guardians giving reasons. Lessons and activities are not transferable or refundable.

#### Kids/Young Teens

Whilst a GV Malta staff member is accessible 24 hours a day, the kids and teen programmes do not include 24-hour supervision. Kids are to be accompanied by their parent/guardian immediately before the start and after the end of their lessons. Students under the age of 14 are only accepted by the school/host families if accompanied to Malta by a parent/guardian. By enrolling your child at Global Village English Centre you are providing us to act on your behalf in the case of an emergency.

### **Pocket Money**

Parents/guardians should ensure their children have sufficient money for the duration of their stay. In case of emergency the school will provide pocket money upon receipt of said money in the GV account. This will incur a charge of €20 per transaction, deducted from the sum deposited into GV's account.

### **Liability**

Students are liable for any damage caused to school premises or accommodation. Before departure students must pay the full cost of any damage they caused to property. Global Village English Centre will not be held liable for loss, damage or injury to persons or property.

### **Dismissal**

GV Malta reserves the right to dismiss students for unacceptable behaviour or lack of attendance. No refund will be given. Repatriation is at students' own expense.

### **Visas**

Students needing an entry visa for Malta must apply for a visa in their own country prior to arrival in Malta. Documents from the school will be issued upon receipt of full payment. Any postal charges incurred will be payable by the student. GV Malta cannot be held responsible for decisions taken by Maltese/foreign Authorities regarding entry visas or visa extensions. A refund less €120.00 + any bank charges + postal charges will be given within 30 days of written proof of visa refusal.

### **Insurance**

All students MUST have adequate travel, accident and medical insurance before they arrive in Malta. Those who do not have this insurance will not be allowed to participate in any of our programmes or leisure activities. We want to make sure that all students will be covered for any eventuality. Copies of insurance coverage are to be sent to the school prior to arrival.

### **Enrolment changes**

Any changes to a student's enrolment after initial confirmation will incur an administrative fee of €20 per change. This also includes requests for changes whilst the student is at school. While we will do our best to change or postpone the course/accommodation when requested, this may however not always be possible. It is not possible to change from group to private/semi-private lessons after a course has started. If a student, while in Malta, wishes to change less than 2 weeks of his/her booked accommodation, s/he will be subject to an extra cost of 4 days of the original accommodation booked. If a student wishes to change 2 weeks or more of his/her booked accommodation, s/he will be subject to an extra cost of 1 week of the original accommodation booked.

### **Cancellation Policy**

In the event that a cancellation is made after our confirmation, the following cancellation policy will apply:

- a) All students cancelling over 14 days prior to the course or accommodation start date (whichever comes first), GV will refund fees received in full less non-refundable charges (registration fee and bank charges)
- b) All students cancelling 14 days or fewer prior to the course or accommodation start date (whichever comes first), will be charged a cancellation fee equivalent to 1 week of accommodation and tuition, registration fee and bank charges.
- c) No refunds will be given by the school for 'no shows', once the student has arrived in Malta or started his/her course (whichever comes first). However course can be shortened as follows:

Courses 1 – 7 weeks: Courses cannot be cancelled, shortened or lessons reduced in number. Tuition fees are not refundable.

Courses 8 - 11 weeks: Students can shorten course by a maximum of 2 weeks. Students must give a 2 week period of notice. The resulting credit can only be used to upgrade tuition and is subject to availability. Credit is not transferable or refundable.

Courses 12 weeks or more: Students can shorten course by a maximum of 4 weeks. Students must give a 2 week period of notice. The resulting credit can only be used to upgrade tuition and is subject to availability. Credit is not transferable or refundable.

### **Force Majeure**

GV Malta will not be responsible for any failure to comply with any of its obligations (and, therefore, shall not be required to provide any compensation) if the failure is occasioned by any cause beyond GV Malta's reasonable control; nor shall GV Malta be responsible for any costs incurred by or on behalf of the student as a result of any such cause. Such causes shall include but shall not be limited to war, threat of war, riot, civil strife, industrial dispute, terrorist activity, natural or nuclear disaster, unusually adverse weather conditions and infectious diseases.

### **Complaints procedure**

If, at any time throughout the course, students are not happy with any area of their stay, they are to inform the school in writing *before* their departure. No complaint can be accepted by Global Village English Centre *after* the end of the relevant course if it has not been brought to the school's attention as explained above.

### School Residential Apartments: (recommended)

**New for 2010**

Our newly-renovated and family-run apartments are ideally located in the centre of the town and only 15-minutes walking distance of the school. Meet other Global Village students from around the world, practise your English and have fun!

Students travelling alone can book shared or single options. Limited availability for single rooms in high season.

Each studio, one-bedroom and two-bedroom apartment has a kitchenette with the necessary self-catering equipment and utensils, dining table and chairs and bathroom/shower. Each bedroom contains a wardrobe, desk/small table and chair, up to three beds and a fan.

Included in the price:

- Welcome drink on arrival.
- FREE use of roof garden and splash pool (April – October).
- FREE WiFi up to 500 MB download per week. Every 500 MB extra costs 5 Euro (payable at the residence)
- Bed linen and towels provided and changed weekly.
- Cleaning service weekly.
- Shared or Private showers/bathrooms.
- Fan.
- Iron & ironing board.
- Water & electricity.

Optional Extras to be paid directly at the residence:

- Heater: €2.00 daily.

### Mediterranea Hotel and Suites: ★★★★★ (school rating ★★★)

The Mediterranea apartments are located only 5 minutes walk from the school. Facilities include a restaurant and coffee shop overlooking the bay, a small fitness centre and sauna, laundry facilities, roof top swimming pool and sun terrace as well as a large Jacuzzi.

Each studio, one-bedroom and two-bedroom apartment is fitted with rustic furniture, a private bathroom, direct dial telephone, satellite television, and radio, air-conditioning and ceiling fans. The studios also provide a dining area and kitchenette, whilst one/two bedroom apartments include a private bathroom, a separate shower room, a living area with armchairs and double sofa bed, and a fully equipped kitchen.

### Soreda Apartments: ★★★★★ (school rating ★★★)

Soreda apartments are situated about 25 minutes away from the school in Qawra. Amenities include restaurants, Piano lounge and bar, a small fitness centre, indoor pool, a 10-metre roof top swimming pool and sun terrace.

Each studio, one bedroom and two-bedroom apartment has a kitchenette, lounge area, private bathroom, direct dial telephone, satellite television, radio, air-conditioning and heating.

The Crown Hotel is located in the heart of St. Paul's Bay, only 5 minutes walk from the school and promenade. All bedrooms are stylish and equipped with air-conditioning and central heating, direct-dial telephone, mini-bar, satellite TV and hair dryer.
